


## Progression through the NSW criminal court system 2017 to 2021



#### **COURT FINALISATIONS BY JURISDICTION**

93% of all criminal court finalisations are in the Local Court



Change in volume of finalisations within each jurisdiction, from 2020 to 2021:

- Local court:
- **3.1%** (from 117,023 to 120,695)
- Higher court:
- **6.6%** (from 3,836 to 3,581)
- Children's court:
- **3.3%** (from 5,646 to 5,462)

#### **BAIL REFUSAL**

### **Bail status at finalisation**



The **proportion** of defendants bail refused at time of court finalisation as remained reasonably

- past 2 years down slightly by 0.2 percentage points.
- past 5 years up slightly by 0.4 percentage points.

The **number** of bail refused at time of court finalisation was the lowest in the past 5 years:

- past 2 years down by 130 persons
- past 5 years down by 383 persons.

**COURT FINALISATIONS BY MOST SERIOUS OFFENCE** 

Criminal Court finalisations by top 10 offence types and 24 month trend, 2021

Of the **129,738** finalisations in 2021, **25.5**% (or 33,124) were for Traffic and vehicle

regulatory offences.

In the 2 years to December 2021:

- Miscellaneous offences increased by 106% or 2,095 finalisations. This was due to COVID related public health breaches.
- Theft offences fell by 7.1% or 603 finalisations.


# Progression through the NSW criminal court system 2017 to 2021




Of the **129,738** persons with a finalised court appearance in the past 12 months:

- 90.3% were found guilty.
- 4.8% were withdrawn by prosecution.








The most common principal penalty types imposed by the NSW Criminal Courts 2021 was a:

• **fine 38.2%** (44,709 persons).

The **proportion** of convicted offenders who received a supervised community sentence **increased** over 5 years from 14.5% to **20.1%**; while the proportion who received an unsupervised community sentence **fell** from 29.6% to **23.2%**.

In 2021, **9.6%** of convicted offenders received a prison sentence. In the past 5 years, the **proportion** of convicted offenders receiving a custodial sentence has fallen from 10.6% in 2017 to 9.6% in 2021.

The number of persons receiving a prison sentenced has **fallen** by **2,351** persons over the past 5 years.



COVID impact: changes made to court operations to protect the safety of court users led to a general decline in the number of criminal court finalisations in 2020, and again in 2021 following the outbreak of the Delta variant. This should be considered when interpreting data for the last 24 months as this period may not represent the long term trends of the NSW Criminal Courts.
