


Persons proceeded against by NSW Police Force for a COVID related breach of the Public Health Act 2010: March 2020* to September 2021

Between March* 2020 and September 2021, **56,314 persons** were proceeded against by NSW Police for a COVID related breach of the Public Health Act 2010.

From July to September 2021, **52,116 people** were proceeded against for a COVID breach. This is **93%** of the total since the beginning of the pandemic.

Number of persons proceeded against for a COVID related breach




Persons proceeded against by NSW police force for a COVID related breach by type of proceeding


Between March 2020 and September 2021 :

- Fines:** 48,942 persons or 87%
July to September 2021 only: 45,962 persons or 88%
- CANs (Court Attendance Notices):** 5,052 persons or 9% July to September 2021 only: 4,665 persons or 9%
- Other- Youth Warning, Caution, Youth Justice Conference:** 2,298 persons aged 10-17 or 4%
July to September 2021 only: 1,472 persons or 3%


% of persons proceeded against by fine or CAN



Gender of persons proceeded against for a COVID related breach, July to September 2021




Age of persons proceeded against for a COVID related breach July to September 2021




In the three months July to September 2021, within Greater Sydney, **Sydney LGA** has had the highest rate of residents proceeded against for a breach of the Public Health Act. Within Regional NSW, **Coonamble LGA** has had the highest rate of proceedings.
