



Of the **37,916** DV court finalisations in 2024:

- **54%** (**20,395**) involved a DV assault charge
- 40% (15,168) involved a Breach Apprehended Domestic Violence Order charge
- 35% (13,398) involved DV intimidation/stalking charge
- 19% (7,303) involved DV property damage charge
- 3% (999) involved a DV sexual offence charge







DV assault: trends in court outcomes



Of the **20,395** DV assault court finalisations in 2024:

- 12,171 (60%) had a proven charge
- 5,444 (27%) had all charges withdrawn
- 1,517 (7%) had no proven charges
- 1,263 (6%) had an 'other' outcome*
- * Dismissed by lower courts due to mental illness and otherwise disposed of.



DV assault: penalties


In 2024, there were **8,427** defendants convicted of DV assault as the principal proven offence:


- 3,422 (41%) received an unsupervised community order
- 2,955 (35%) received a supervised community order
- 1,029 (12%) were sentenced to a prison sentence

The **proportion** of people sentenced to prison for DV assault has remained stable




DV Assault: time to justice
