



SEXUAL ASSAULT INCIDENTS

Sexual assaults recorded by NSW Police can be further categorised into three types:

In 2023, of the 9,456 sexual assault incidents were;
45% adult victims reported as adult: 4,214
30% child victims reported when child: 2,870
25% child victims reported

25% child victims reported when adult: **2,372**

Note 1: the time period presented is based on the date the incident was reported to police not the date the incident occurred.

Note 2. <u>Adult victim of sexual assault</u> in this report is defined as a person aged 16 and over. This reflects the legal status of person aged 16 and over to provide consent.


Child victim reported when child includes victims under the age of 16 at the time of both the incident and reporting.

Child victim reported when adult includes victims under the under the age of 16 at the time of incident, but aged 16 years or over at the time of reporting.

Sexual assault - incidents and victims



• 44% were by current/former intimate partner.


* Excludes 28 victims with missing age or gender

- 12% of adult sexual assaults the offender was not known to the victim.
- 79% of incidents occurred at a residential premises (3,329).
 - ^ Excludes 213 victims with missing relationship information


ADULT (16+) VICTIMS In 2023, of the 4,227 adult victims of sexual assault:

- 89% of victims were female.
- 29% were aged between 18 and 25 years at the time of incident.

Victim to offender relationship types, n=4,014^ 37.3% Other known




CHILD VICTIMS REPORTED WHEN CHILD




- * Excludes 41 victims with missing age or gender
- 34% of perpetrators were family members
- 21% of perpetrators were a current or ex boyfriend or girlfriend.
- 84% of incidents occurred at a residential premises (2,587).
 - ^ Excludes 337 victims with missing relationship information

In 2023, of the **3,074** child victims of sexual assault, who reported the incident when child;

- **81%** were female.
- 66% were aged 11 to 15 at the time of the incident.



CHILD VICTIMS REPORTED WHEN ADULT



- * Excludes 13 victims with missing age or gender
- 35% of perpetrators were a family member.
- 18% of perpetrators were a person in authority (including carer)
- 70% of incidents occurred at a residential premises (1,669).

^ Excludes 77 victims with missing relationship information

In 2023, of the **2,392** child victims of sexual assault, who reported the incident when adult (historical child sexual assault reports);

- 67% were female.
- 48% were aged 10 years or under at the incident.

Victim to offender relationship types, n=2,315^



Note 3: Victim and offender relationship types: <u>Intimate Partner</u>: current & ex-spouse/partner, current & ex-boy/girl friend. <u>Family</u>: child, parent, sibling, other family. <u>Other known person</u>: e.g. acquaintance, colleague, ex-partner of partner & household member. <u>Person in authority</u>: includes persons in authority (e.g. teacher, medical, religious leader, social worker, employer and government worker) and carer. <u>Not known to victim</u>.
