### **Instrument Delegating Powers to Registrars**

#### 1. Introduction

Pursuant to s.13 of the *Civil Procedure Act 2005* (NSW), the senior judicial officer of any court may, by instrument in writing, direct that any function of the court under the Act or any other Act or law in respect of which the court has jurisdiction (including any rules of court) may be exercised by such registrars or other officers of the court, and in such circumstances and subject to such conditions, as are specified in the instrument; and may vary or revoke any such instrument.

Pursuant to s.19(1) of the *Local Court Act 2007* (NSW), a registrar has and may exercise the functions conferred on a registrar by or under the Act, the rules or any other Act or law.

Pursuant to s.19(3) of the *Local Court Act 2007* (NSW), a person employed as a deputy registrar has, under the registrar, all of the functions of the registrar and may exercise those functions in respect of any place in the State at which the registrar may exercise the functions.

### 2. Direction

Pursuant to s.13 of the *Civil Procedure Act 2005* (NSW), I direct that a registrar of the Local Court may exercise the powers of the Court conferred by the legislation listed in Column 1 and described in Column 2, but subject to any restrictions listed in Column 3, of the Schedule below.

## **3.** Further delegation

- 3.1 Pursuant to s.13 of the *Civil Procedure Act 2005* (NSW), I further direct that a registrar of the Local Court may exercise the powers of the Court conferred by the *Civil Procedure Act 2005* (NSW) and the *Uniform Civil Procedure Rules 2005* (NSW) in respect of civil proceedings where the exercise of that power by the registrar is done with the consent of the parties to the proceedings.
- 3.2 I further direct that a registrar of the Local Court may exercise the functions of the Court to: -
  - (a) Waive, postpone and remit fees as referred to in cl.17(3) of the *Criminal Procedure Regulations 2005* (NSW).
  - (b) Waive, postpone and remit fees as referred to in cl.11 of the *Civil Procedure Regulations 2005* (NSW).
