
Connect to the network via monitor or WiFi

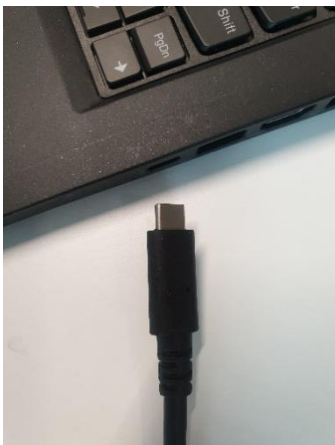
There are three ways you can connect to the network and or internet:

1. [Monitor cable at a workpoint](#): Only DCJ laptops of devices can access this connection. This will connect you to the network and intranet.
2. [WiFi: DCJ_CORP](#): Only DCJ laptops of devices can access this connection. This will connect you to the network and intranet.
3. [WiFi DCJ_GUEST](#): will give you access to the internet but not the DCJ network. Use this connection on your personal devices or for external visitor (guest) access to the internet.

See below for how to access each.

1. Connect to the network and internet via the monitor cable

- 1 Each workpoint monitor comes with a **USB-C cable**. Connect this to your laptop to connect to the network and internet.







Note: This cable will also charge your laptop and connect your monitor.

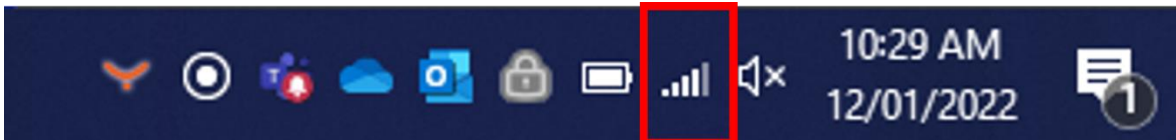
- 2 Once connected you will see the network symbol in the bottom right-hand corner of the screen.



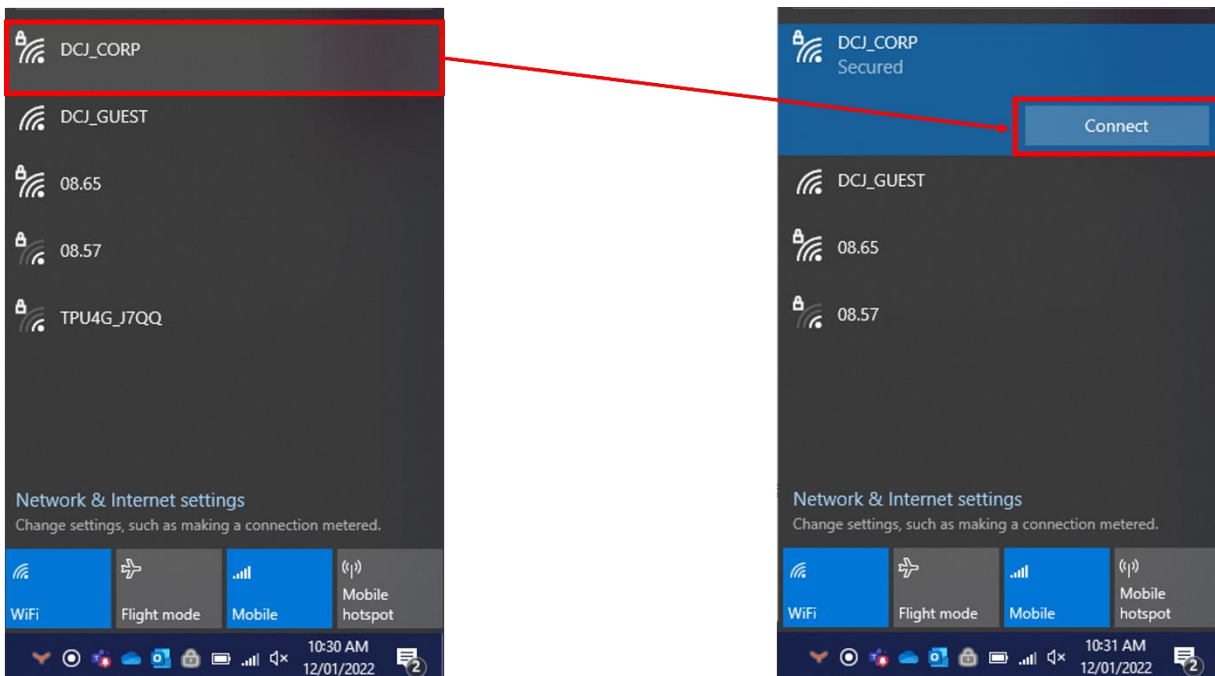
2. Connect to DCJ_CORP WiFi

- 1 Connect to DCJ_CORP for Wi-Fi network and internet access from your DCJ devices. The network icon in your taskbar will display your current connection type and will provide access to all available connections. The icon could be a LAN icon (), a WiFi icon (), the no network icon () or a mobile coverage icon ()

First, select the Internet Access icon to view the available WiFi networks.



- 2 The available networks will be displayed. Select DJC_CORP and then Connect.



Note: No additional login or password will be required. Your device will be authenticated automatically.

Note: If your laptop uses a sim card for mobile coverage, it is recommended you turn off the mobile network connection while in the building. The WiFi will give you a better in-building experience.

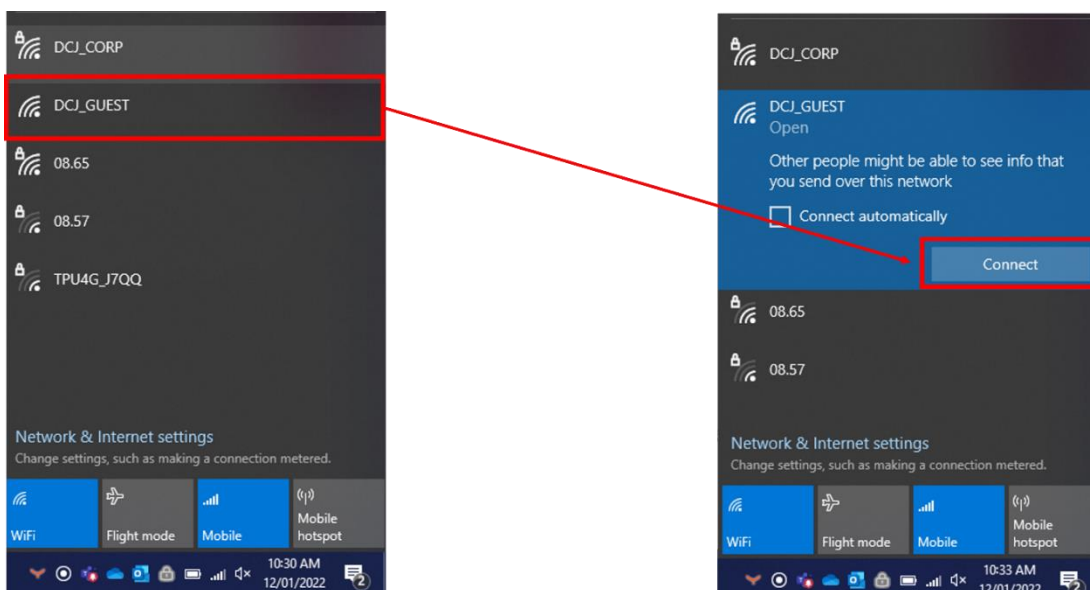
3. Connect to the DCJ_GUEST WiFi

- 1 Connect to DCJ_GUEST for internet only access from your personal devices or for use by external visitors. First, select the Network Symbol to view the available WiFi networks.



Note: You may also see the WiFi symbol (📶) or the no network symbol (🌐).

- 2 The available networks will be displayed. Select DCJ_GUEST and then Connect.



- 3 The Acceptable Use Policy will launch in a browser window. Read the Disclaimer and select Accept.
